Here are a few examples of the issues that the students will deal with.


They will record their favourite sounds and five sounds that represent their cities. Will these recordings illustrate our cultural differences?

They will create an ear-book where all the sounds will be gathered so that everyone can listen to them. Will it enable you to imagine what a person or a place is like?

The City Rings project officially started in Bergen on September 28, 2015 when the teachers and the six Norwegian pupils who will take part in it presented the

programme to the County Mayor,

the Director of Education, the principal of Laksevåg Upper Secondary School and representatives of the Erasmus + agency in Norway.

When will the pupils meet?

Of course, this project would be nothing without the pupils. Several bilateral exchanges will take place in the next two years and two multinational meetings will be held. The first one will take place in Vasa (February 2016) and the second one in Waregem (March 2017).

About 80 students coming from six different countries, will then communicate in English, work together, exchange ideas, solve problems and cooperate and we know they will love it!
